

State Meet Selection / In-Gym Requirements

Any judge who wishes to be considered for assignment to a USAG State Meet must fill out the Georgia USAG/NAWGJ Application for the State Meet Judging Assignment form and return it our State Judging Director by the deadline. Several key items must be met before the GA-USAG Board, which has the right to accept or reject any proposed judge, can consider this judge for the state meet:

- You must attend at least one clinic every year with at least 4 credit hours. There are many choices from which to choose to fulfill this requirement; we will try to always have at least one choice within easy driving distance of Atlanta.
- You must book **AT LEAST THREE MEETS PER SEASON AT THE LEVEL OF THE STATE MEET FOR WHICH YOU WISH TO BE CONSIDERED.**
- You must have in-gym experience to be considered for a state meet assignment. If you turn in the Region 8 In Gym Experience Card (due June 1st to the region), which asks for a minimum of 9 hours spent in the gym with training gymnasts at the Level 8, 9, 10, Elite or Collegiate level, you must make a copy of this card and send it to the GA-SJD, Jean DeArmon, by **August 31st** of the current year. If you do not fill this regionally-mandated card, you must send in the **STATE IN-GYM CARD** with at least 6 hours in gym with training athletes every year.
- **As stated in the *Rules and Policies* the Georgia USA Board reserves the rights to reject or remove any judge from a state meet for inappropriate behavior or lack of professional ethics that would be deemed unsuitable for assignment to a state meet.**
